COMMERCE ASSOCIATION

Commerce association was inaugurated on 8th Aug. 2006 by Shri.C.V.Narayanan, Principal Officer, Futurance India Insurance (P) Ltd, Trichy. In his speech he highlighted the methods and importance of various schemes of insurance.

A Workshop on Capital Share Market was held in the Dept. of Commerce on Sep.25, 2006. Mr. N. Srinivasan, Director, Yoga Securities, Chennai was the Chief Guest. He explained the far-reaching changes that have taken place in the share market since 1992. The advent of screen based trading, dematerialization, entry of Foreign Institutional Investors etc., have led to mind blowing growth of volumes in the market, he said. The average daily turnover of NSE was in the region of Rs.5000 crores and market capitalization exceeded Rs.30 lakh crores, he added. Mr. Srinivasan shared a few secrets of stock trading. Combination of Money, Mind, Method and Target, according to him, is a potent recipe for success in the share market.



Mr. Elaiya Bharathi, Equity Research Analyst, Yoha Securities listed the advantage of investing in shares. He explained the methodology for selection of good shares. Fundamental analysis involves a study of a wide range of factors social, legal, economical and SWOT Analysis, he added. He also said that technical Analysis is concerned with price movements and Learning, Surviving and Mastering were the components of the process of successful investing. Mr. R. Pitchumani, Business Executive, Motilal Oswal Securities elucidated the winning strategies for investment. Picking the right stocks, timing, limiting the greed, overcoming the panic for systematic

approach are the rudimentary elements in successful stock market operation, he added.

Commerce Association conducted a meeting on Sep.16, 2006. The Chief guest, Mr. Pandian, Senior Manager, Indian Overseas Bank succinctly brought into focus the recent trends in banking. He explained how the concept of Self Help Groups (SHG) was evolved in Bangladesh by a Professor who was overwhelmed by the promptness of a rural daily wage earner in repayment of a small loan. He enlightened the students regarding the prudential norms, provisioning norms as well as the modus operandi of the classification of assets. Mr.Pandian vividly brought forth the tools of financial analysis used by bankers. In response to questions from the students, he touched upon recovery mechanism, impact of technology as well as facilities of educational loans etc.

ECONOMICS ASSOCIATION

Economics Association was inaugurated on Sep.26, 2006 by Dr.N.Manimekalai, Director, Centre for Women's Studies, Bharthidasan University, Tiruchirapalli. In her speech on "Gender Issues in Development", she listed out the economic and social factors contributing to the problems of present day women. SANSKRIT ASSOCIATION

The inaugural meeting of the Sanskrit association was held on 01-08-2006. Dr.A.S. ARAVAMUDHAN, Ph.D., Professor of Mimansa, Sri Lal Bahadur Shastri Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapith, New Delhi (Under the Ministry of HRD) delivered a lecture on "Importance of learning Sanskrit – Sanskrit for all". He brought out the similarities between the Indian languages, particularly vernacular. He identified the words that are used in Tamil, which are identical with that of Sanskrit. Since the culture and habits of the subcontinent of India is unique, the languages too carry the same words to express them, he added. Since Sanskrit belongs to the family of Indo-European languages, it has global reach. He pointed out that much research is going on in the field of National language Processing in computers and to make Sanskrit compatible to computers. Dr.M.N.Abubacker, who presided over the function, identified Botany in Sanskrit literature.

THE U.G.C SPONSORED NATIONAL SEMINAR ON TRANSLATION AS A TOOL TO PROMOTE NATIONAL INTEGRATION AND SOCIAL AWARENESS

The U.G.C sponsored National Seminar on Translation as a Tool to promote National Integration and Social Awareness was conducted by the Dept. of English for 3 days from 27-09-06 to 29-09-06 at the New Auditorium. Leading academicians and eminent public figures participated in the seminar.



The Inaugural Address was delivered by Dr. K.Chellappan, Retd, Professor of English, Bharathidasan University while the key note address by P.D.T. Achary, Secretary General, Lok Sabha was read by Mr. John Sundar, Senior Interpreter of Lok Sabha. Mr. K.Vijayakumar, Additional Director General of Police STF, Madras, spoke on the importance of knowledge in mother tongue in winning the confidence and intimacy of people. Dr. Padmaja Devi, Professor of Hindi, Sri Vankateswara University pointed out the role of Hindi as a link language in Translation. Dr. Radha Krishnan of Tamil University, Tanjore stressed the essential need for integration of the states through Translation. Mr. John Sundar, Senior Interpreter of Lok Sabha narrated the crucial role of interpretation in Parliament through his practical experiences in the field down the decades.

The second day of the seminar marked a variety of speeches by leading academicians in relation to the theme of the seminar. Dr. Prema Nandakumar, a well known Translator, shared her experiences in translating the Classical Tamil Literature while Dr. T.N. Ramachandran an advocate/Translator traced the evolution of translation from tradition to modernity. Prof. K.G.Seshadhri a translator of Bharathi's poems pointed out the element of not only national but also global integration in Bharathi. Dr. Joseph Iradhayaraj HOD, Dept of HRD, SJ. Joseph's college and a former NSS coordinator of Bharathidasan University, narrated how he was able to cultivate the element Social Awareness in rural India through Translation. Dr. Lingaraj, Reader in English, Mysore University, traced the impact of Translation from the colonization of the British up to the modern globalization. Mr. V.K. Lakshmi Narayanan Former DGP Tamilnadu highlighted the utility and creativity in Translation for a peaceful and orderly society.

The valedictory address on the third day by Dr. V.Ramaswamy, Reader in English, EVR College, Trichy pointed out the intricacies of Translation and how certain things become untranslatable. Dr. Palani Arokyaswamy eloquently described the same concept with lots of examples in Tamil and English. Mr. M.S.Venkatachalam, a leading Translator spoke on the Cultural sensibility in translation while Dr.D.Kingsly M.D. DCH

spoke on the problems of translating scientific texts. Dr. N. Seshadhri, former Principal, National College, humorously narrated how translation at times becomes misleading and funny.

The seminar had participants from Thirupathy, Karnataka, Calicut and Delhi . More than fifty papers were presented in the afternoon parallel sessions in all the three days. Students of P.S.G. AWARENESS IN DIABETES

Dr.M.SHANMUGAVELU M.D. Physician/ Diabetologist, Diabetes Specialty Centre, Thillainagar, Trichy 620018, delivered a special lecture on AWARENESS IN DIABETES on 30th June 2006. He pointed out that ten percent of the population of our country suffer from diabetes. While he was discussing the causes for diabetes he classified them into genetical / occupational / food habit. He also stressed the importance of stress free life in controlling the disease. He advocated the practice of yoga and brisk walk for 40 minutes a day especially in the early hours for the diabetic patients. Awareness in food habits, consuming balanced diet, including fiber rich food and avoiding fatty foods will prevent heart and eye problems and help to maintain good health, he added.

ANTICANCER PROPERTIES OF GREEN TEA

On Sep.12, 2006, Dr. T.S.Saravanan, Reader, Dept. of Zoology, Jamal Mohamed College, Tiruchirapalli spoke on anticancer properties of Catechins especially Epicatechingallate (ECG) and Epigallocatechin gallate (EGCG) present in green tea and their effects on to suppress the growth of cancer cell lines derived from tumors of patients. In the speech he said that there are four Poluphenols present in green tea leaves and they are Epicatechin (EC), Epicatechingallate (ECG), Epigallocatechin (EGC) and Epigallocatechingallate (EGCG) and these are often collectively called as Catechins. As powerful antioxidants, they have been shown to inhibit proliferation of cancer cell, fight against viruses, slow ageing and also other beneficial effects on health, he added. Clinical tests have shown that Catechins destroy free radicals which have far reaching positive effects on the entire body.
