BOTANY ASSOCIATION

Dr.R.MOHANRAJ, Lecturer, Dept. of Environmental Management, Bharathidasan University, delivered a lecture on "IMPLICATION OF CLIMATIC CHANGES" at the Valedictory meeting of Botany Association held on 16<sup>th</sup> March 2007. He asserted that most of the global warming observed over the last 50 years is attributed to human activity and that the CO2 concentration has increased from 330ppm in 1970 to 380 ppm in 2004. He also spoke on El Nino / La Nina effects, which refer to extreme climatic changes in globe warranting a change in agricultural pattern. Since this effect would result in reduction of crop yield, sea level rise, decrease in ground water resources, change in terrestrial ecosystem, marine ecosystem, and bio-diversity loss etc., He stressed that mankind must protect the Environment and save the earth.

Chemistry Association



Dr.M.G.Sethuraman, Reader, Department of Chemistry, Gandigram Rural University, Gandigram, spoke on "Drug Toxicity" on 24-01-2007. He explained various ill effects of common drugs used in day to day life.
