MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)
AND ACADEMIC COLLABORATION

BETWEEN

Department of History
National College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli-620001
and

Department of History
Arasu College of Arts and Science for Women, Karur-639006

National College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli and Arasu College of Arts and Science for Women, Karur aim to establish and develop a close partnership to promote academic and cultural exchanges between the two Institutions through mutual assistance, specially, in the areas of teaching and research.

This Agreement of Co-operation, upon approval of the Secretary of National College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli and the Chairman of Arasu College of Arts and Science for Women, Karur will serve as a general framework for institutional co-operation. It will facilitate faculty members to discuss and develop specific programs of co-operation. Each Institution will



designate a liaison officer to co-ordinate the application of this Agreement in the best interest of both Institutions. Co-operative relations shall be carried out through the activities such as:

➤ **Student Exchange:**

Both institutions agree to facilitate short-term student exchange programs. The objective is to provide students with opportunities to experience varied academic environments, enhance cross-cultural understanding, and develop advanced linguistic and literary competencies. The exchange shall be recognized by both institutions, subject to prior approval of the respective heads of the department.

➤ **Faculty Exchange:** The parties agree to promote mutual faculty exchange for the purposes of teaching, research collaboration, curriculum development, and academic mentoring. Faculty members from either institution may be invited to deliver lectures, conduct workshops, supervise research projects, and participate in syllabus design. Exchange duration and responsibilities shall be determined jointly, with due consideration for academic schedules and institutional policies.

➤ **Sharing Resources:** Both departments agree to share academic resources, including library materials, e-resources, research databases, and teaching aids, wherever feasible and permissible. Access to such resources shall be granted to support joint research projects, comparative studies, and innovative pedagogy. Where applicable, digital access credentials or physical copies of reference materials shall be provided under mutually agreed guidelines, ensuring compliance with copyright laws.

➤ **Collaborative Events:** The parties will jointly organize seminars, conferences, literary festivals, workshops, and competitions to promote scholarship and cultural exchange. These events may be conducted in-person, online, or in hybrid mode, enabling participation of students and faculty from both institutions. Collaborative events shall focus on themes relevant to literature, language studies, communication skills, and interdisciplinary approaches, with equal representation from both sides in planning and execution.

➤ **No Legal Bindings:** There is no binding and the parties acknowledge that this MoU does not place them under any legal obligation.

The provisions and activities specified in this agreement are subjected to the availability of funds and the approval of the authorities of both Institutions. A separate financial agreement to be finalized prior to any particular program and academic activities or collaboration research.

The agreement shall take effect from the date of signing and shall be valid for an initial period of 5 (five) years. Any amendment and/or modification of this agreement require the written

approval of the Principal of both the institutions. Neither Institution shall act relative to this Agreement without consultation with the partner in this agreement.
