 It is resolved to include 75% of core and elective courses from the TANSCHE syllabus.

- As per the Department Advisory Board, in this BoS (2019 -2020), 20% of the existing syllabus is revised.
- It is resolved to provide equal credits to all the core courses irrespective of contact hours.
- It is resolved to give 5 credits for core courses, 4 credits for elective courses, 3 credits for ancillary courses, 3 credits for practical papers and 2 credits for all other papers in the UG course.
- It is resolved to follow same credits for Tamil and English as per TANSCHE regulations.
- It is resolved to add Value added courses like i) R-Programming ii) Latex and iii) Scilab to B.Sc. and M.Sc. Programs.
- It is resolved to include the marks of value added courses in the mark statement, and to exclude in the CGPA calculation.
- It is recommended by the industrialist to conduct career guidance classes per semester with the external expert and also to have an Industrial visit once a year.
- It is recommended by the BoS to have the new structure for M.Sc. course with the following components: 4 core courses and 1 elective course in I, II,3 core courses and 2 elective course III semester and 3 core courses, 1 elective course and 1 project work for IV semester.




