STUDENTS SATISFACTION SURVEY (SSS)

A Students Satisfaction Survey was conducted among students from the Arts, Science and Commerce & Management streams to assess the quality of institutional services and identify areas requiring improvement. Two thousand and Five hundred (2500) plus students actively participated in the SSS representing all major academic streams. Stream-wise responses included 1495 from the Science stream, 763 from the Commerce & Management stream and 262 from the Arts stream, ensuring representation from diverse academic disciplines. The responses collected were systematically compiled and analyzed, and the concerns and suggestions raised by the students were carefully reviewed by the concerned authorities. Based on the survey findings, appropriate corrective measures and necessary follow-up actions were initiated to enhance service quality, improve student satisfaction and support the institution's continuous quality improvement initiatives.

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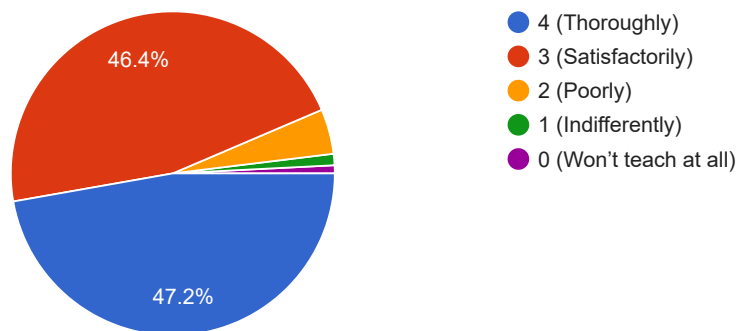

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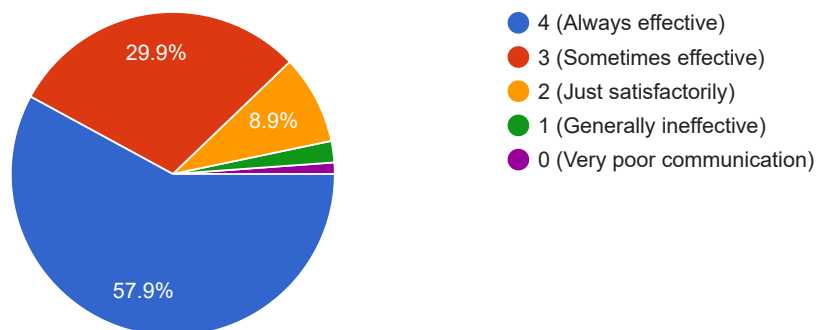

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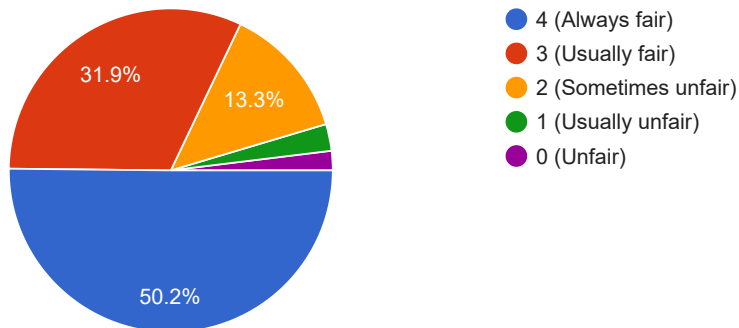
